INTRODUCTION


The first quarters accounts covering the Covid-19 pandemic have now been ascertained.

In comparison to 2019.20 the first quarters figures for Income from Hythe Town Council assets are listed below;

Since some of the sports restrictions have been lifted, the use of a contactless device to receive payments has enabled residents to pay for tennis without the need to handle cash and this has proved successful with a rise in the income to cover the initial loss in April.



The Town Council's expenditure has not yet been reduced by a significant enough amount to compensate for any such loss. This is largely due to costs for emergency tree works, skate park maintenance and an increase in general rates. Any savings to be made on budgeted items will not become apparent until towards the end of the financial year.
