**PORTLAND ROAD, HYTHE**

**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**

**TEMPORARY ORDER 2021**

**To allow sewer repair works to be carried out to replace a manhole frame and cover, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Portland Road, Hythe.**

**A closure is currently planned for Tuesday 13 April 2021 for an estimated period of up to 6 hours.**

**In the event of any unforeseen problems, it may be necessary to extend the duration or close the road the following day.**

**Portland Road will be closed between the junctions with St Leonard's Road and A259 Dymchurch Road, to actual the extent shown.**

**The alternative routes for through traffic are**  
***Westbound* via Stade Street, A259 Rampart Road, Red Lion Square and Dymchurch Road**

***Eastbound* via A259 Dymchurch Road, Scanlons Bridge Road, Military Road, Rampart Road and Stade Street**

**The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation and adverse weather conditions, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.**
