TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Cinque Ports Avenue, Hythe will be closed to through traffic, on or after 04th January 2022 for up to 11 days.

The road will be closed at 40 Cinque Ports Avenue.

The alternative route is via Cinque Ports Avenue and St Leonard's Road.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 09:00 hrs and 18:00 hrs each day.

This closure is necessary to enable sewer repairs to be carried out by Southern Water.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.
