Subject HORN STREET EQUIPMENT, ANIMALS AND SKATE

PARK REPORT F&GP/29/21

SUMMARY: This report provides information on a public consultation on the following projects: Play Equipment at Horn Street Recreation Ground, the Wooden Animal Trail and the Skate Park Shelter

REASON FOR RECOMMENDATION:

The Committee is asked to agree the recommendations set out below because;-

a) The Council is committed to control and manage its financial affairs in accordance with The National Association of Local Councils (NALC) guidelines.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1. To receive and note the report F&GP/29/21
- 2. To install one the Play Equipment options set out below at Horn Street Recreation Ground.
- 3. To choose an open space and install four animals for the animal trail.
- 4. To refurbish the current play equipment at Horn Street in Primary Colours.
- 5. To install skatepark shelter option C into the Skate Park, Hythe.
- 6. To vire the cost of the agreed expenditure from CIL Reserves to Budget code 5003 CIL Expenditure.

INTRODUCTION

The Good Practice Guide states that 'All children do not need to access play spaces in the same way, but they are fundamentally entitled to go out to play. Good design of public play spaces is needed to make this possible. Each child is different- not every piece of equipment in a play space needs to be accessible to every child but access to the social experience of play is key.'

HORN STREET RECREATION GROUND

It is proposed to install new play equipment to enhance Horn Street Recreation Ground. Expanding the playground equipment will ensure that all users are able to enjoy it and all children will have an equal opportunity to access the social experience of play.

The resulted showed that the public would like to see the current equipment painted in bright primary colours.





Skate Park Shelter




Option C was most popular shelter for the Skate Park.


Wooden Animal Trail

Consultation Results

The results of the consultation showed that the Green was the most popular open Space, followed by Oaklands and Horn Street Recreational Ground. Then Animal I (Grasshopper), Animal D (Snake) and Animal F (Butterfly) were the most popular wooden animals.

SUMMARY

The overall result from the consultation shows that the public would like to see the Play Equipment Option **C** installed into Horn Street and would like the current equipment re-painted with bright primary colours. The re-painting of the current equipment, would be an addiontal cost to the project and quotes will be sought.

The Green was the most popular open space, WITH Animal I (Grasshopper), Animal D (Snake) and Animal F (Butterfly) being the most popular wooden animals.

The overall result from the consultations showed that the public would like Option **C** installed into the Skate Park as the new shelter.

The committee are asked to consider the results of the consultation and which budget should be set for two of the projects, new equipment at Horn Street and the Wooden Animal Trail.

The shelter in the Skate Park, has already been budgeted for from the Projects budget which has a total of £8,200 put aside for projects in 2021-22.

RISK MANAGEMENT

A summary of the perceived risk follows;

Perceived Risk

Council do not refurbish the current Horn Street Play Equipment and it falls into disrepair.

Council do not install new play equipment for a younger age group and only children of a certain age can enjoy the area therefore not providing equipment for all age groups.

Council do not install a skate park shelter and users do not have protection from the weather should they wish to rest.
