**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**  
**THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**TEMPORARY ORDER 2022**

To allow for new utility connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Bartholomew Street, Hythe.

A closure is planned from 31st January 2022, with estimated completion by 4th February 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (XW071W118298256-00059-02 - SGN). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signs showing and/or displayed on [One.Network](#)

Bartholomew Street will be closed in the vicinity of 1 & 2 The Furrows, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while new utility connection works are undertaken by SGN.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Malthouse Hill, High Street, A259 Rampart Road/Prospect Road, East Street Roundabout, Station Road, Dental Street, Bartholomew Street and vice versa.
