CANNONGATE AVENUE & LOWER BLACKHOUSE HILL, HYTHE

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Cannongate Avenue & Lower Blackhouse Hill, Hythe has been closed to through traffic, on or after 3rd May 2022 for up to 14 days.

The road has been closed at outside The Wirral, Cannongate Avenue and at the junction of Lower Blackhouse Hill.

The alternative route for Cannongate Avenue is via Cannongate Road, Cliff Road, Blackhouse Hill.

The alternative route for Lower Blackhouse Hill is via Mill Road and Station Road.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 08:00 hrs and 18:00 hrs each day.

This closure is necessary to enable sewer repairs to be carried out by Southern Water.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.
