Naildown Road, Hythe

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow new utility connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Naildown Road, Hythe.

A closure is planned from 30th June 2022, with estimated completion by 6th July 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (KZ50056557660-01 - UK Power Networks). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

Naildown Road will be closed in the vicinity of number 24, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while new utility connection works are undertaken by UK Power Networks.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Naildown Road, Horn Street, Spring Lane, Highridge and vice versa.
