

Footway Maintenance in Your Area

Footway Surface Improvement (Reconstruction)



Kingfisher Avenue and Martins Way, Hythe

When we plan to carry out the work and how long it will take

This is to let you know that, as part of the on-going maintenance and improvement of the highway network, Kent County Council will be resurfacing the footways in **Kingfisher Avenue and Martins Way, in the sections shown on the plan on the reverse.**

These footway surface improvement works are programmed to start on the **20th June 2022** and are expected to take approximately **20 weeks** to complete. These activities will be undertaken between the hours of **07:00am and 17:00pm** each day.

If there is any change to this date and it is not possible for us to carry it out at this time, we will arrange a new date and let you know via a letter drop to your home. We will also put-up signs along the road, before we start, showing the date we plan to start work.

What we plan to do

The footway is in a poor condition, and we plan to renew it. The areas marked on the map overleaf, will be excavated and the existing surface will be replaced with a new black asphalt surface

We will carry out the work in sections to try to minimise any inconvenience. As we will be digging up the existing footway there will be some noise and dust.
