**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING & SUSPEND ONE-WAY)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow works to coredrill into chamber and lay duct in the footway to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Tanners Hill, Hythe. The one-way order will be suspended to allow access.

A closure is planned between 08:00 hours and 18:00 hours from 13th July 2022, with estimated completion by 15th July 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC417SECHA0000207742ONSA-01 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Tanners Hill will be closed in the vicinity of number 3, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while works to core drill into chamber and lay duct in the footway are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Tanners Hill, North Road, Station Road and vice versa.
