# **Town Mayor's Medals**


The Town Mayor of Hythe would like the opportunity to show his/her appreciation to members of the community who have done something particularly noteworthy in Hythe within the year.

## Criteria for Nominees of the Town Mayor's Civic Medal:

#### 1. All nominees should:

- Not be a local government employee or a Councillor for Hythe.
- Not be employed to perform a specific role in the community.
- Be an unpaid volunteer in the community.
- Be someone that has given up their own time and without prompting and offered to help other people or the community.

#### 2. All nominees should also meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Be someone whose service to the community is worthy of recognition.
- Be someone who deserves recognition for their effort, strength, bravery or achievement.
- Be someone who has achieved something which benefits their local community or even the whole of the Town.

#### Criteria for Nominees of the Town Mayor's Pandemic Medal:

#### 1. All nominees should:

- Not be a local government employee or a Councillor for Hythe.
- Be an someone who made a major contribution to the battle against COVID-19.
- Be an organisation who made a major contribution to the battle against COVID-19.

### 2. All nominees should also meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Be someone/organisation whose service to the community during COVID-19 is worthy of recognition.
- Be someone/organisation who deserves recognition for their effort, strength, bravery or achievement during COVID-19.

#### **Guidance Notes:**

- For those successful, presentations of medals will be made at each Full Council meetings to which the nominees and their nominators will be invited to attend.
- Disclosure of the winners' names will be made on social media and various Town Council publications.
- Nominees will be kept confidential until the point of being notified if successful.
- Each nominee will be assessed on their own merit.

• There will be a maximum of 3 Town Mayor's Civic Medals and 3 Town Mayor's Pandemic Medal at any meeting. It is therefore advisable not to inform the individual(s)/organisation(s) being nominated to avoid disappointment if not successful.
