

Jr use unto the Mayor Alderman and Burgesses of the Borough of Eythe aforesaid (hereinafter in this my Will called "the Corporation") the said premises to be used as a Museum the primary object of the same being to teach the History of the County of Kent from prehistoric times up to the present day but this shall not preclude the inclusion of objects and articles of foreign countries nor of savage races nor any objects or articles of natural history from any part of the World It is my wish that should the Corporation desire at any time to convert the present Town Hall of Hythe aforesaid into and use the same as a kuseum then the Corporation may be allowed to build a new Town Hall with hunicipal Offices (and Public Assembly Rooms for Music and Dancing or like entertainments if desired) either on the site of Oaklands or on any other part of the land coloured pink on the plan drawn herson IT IS ALSO MY WISH that the Corporation shall be allowed to use any part of Oaklands not required for use as part of the Museum as a residence for a caretaker or any official of the Corporation or as municipal Offices

- (17) Small Black Cabinet on legs
- (16) Corner Cupboard
- (19) Small writing table and cupboard above
- (20) The contents of my Museum
- (21) All chica (save modern ching in daily use)
