TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Bartholomew Street, Hythe will be closed to through traffic, on or after 7th June 2023 for up to 3 days.

The road will be closed along the entire length of Bartholomew Street.

There is no alternative route. Every effort will be made to maintain access for residents whenever it is safe to do so.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 09:00 and 16:00 each day.

This closure is necessary to enable kerbing and footway repairs to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
