Temporary Road Closure - Burmarsh Road, Hythe - 4th September 2023 (Folkestone and Hythe District)

It will be necessary to close part of Burmarsh Road, Hythe, from 4th September 2023 with estimated completion by 8th December 2023.

Burmarsh Road, Hythe, will be closed in 3 phases. Once each phase is completed, works for the next phase will begin.

Phase 1 - Burmarsh Road will be closed, between the junctions of Grebe Crescent and Kingfisher Avenue. To the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

Phase 2 - Burmarsh Road will be closed, between the junctions of Kingfisher Avenue and Wych Elm Way. To the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

Phase 3 - Burmarsh Road will be closed, between the junctions of Wych Elm Way and Shepherds Walk. To the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.


The alternative route for any through traffic is via A259 Dymchurch Road, Botolphs Bridge Road, Lower Wall Road and vice versa.
