RECOMMENDATION:

1. To receive and approve the audited financial statements of the Davis Oaklands Charitable Gift to 31 March 2023.

INTRODUCTION

Hythe Town Council is a corporate trustee for Davis Oaklands Charitable Gift. Davis Oaklands is the only charity that holds a trust bank account and has income and expenditure reports.

On 31 March 2023, Davis Oaklands Charitable Gift held £325,832.07 in its current bank account along with investment accounts holding £35,568.18 and £42,730.65.

The Charity has gained £31,980 as income since March 2022 mostly from the rental of the Hythe Library by Kent County Council, annual rent of £23,250.

Each year Davis Oaklands receives payment from Hythe Town Council for an annual loan repayment of £3,600 (paid each December) plus loan interest (paid each April). The money was originally provided to aid the building of the Sports Pavilion. Plans to clear this loan over a 3–5-year period will be discussed at the end of the financial

year by Hythe Town Council. The loan repayment from Hythe Town Council is not accounted as income but as a deduction from the loan.

Investment accounts, Chari bond account has lost £-1,678.59 in value whereas Chari fund has increased by £5,512.

The only regular expenses are the Curator's annual remuneration and expenses. These are paid through Hythe Town Council and recharged to the Charity.

The Charity pays an administration fee to Hythe Town Council of £6,000 per annum to cover administration costs, managing building maintenance and managing the charities accounts.

I have examined the books, records and supporting documentation, which I can confirm agree with the financial statement presented for the year end 31 March 2023, covering the period 1 April 2022 to 31 March 2023 in respect of the activities relating to the Davis Oaklands Charitable Gift for the year.

The Trust Treasury Management Policy requires the Trustees "seek to utilise short-notice accounts and short-dated deposits (up to three months) in order to gain interest." Money not required more immediately can be invested in longer-term deposits with better interest rates. The Natwest Current Account had in excess of £300,000 as at 31 March 2023. Since then interest rates have risen dramatically in recent months (Bank of England base rate increased to 4.25% from March 2023, in March 2022 the base rate was 0.75%).
