**Kent County Council intends to make an Order the
effect of which is to temporarily close Public
Bridleway HB65 from Twiss Road to its junction
with Public Footpath HB76 from the 05 February
2024**

The path will be closed for a maximum of six months, although it is
expected that it will reopen 08 March 2024

The path is to be closed because of planned gas engineering works.

The alternative route for cyclists and equestrians is via Cannongate Bridge
and Bridleway HB83. The pedestrian alternative route is via Public
Footpath HB76, Earlsfield Road and Twiss Road and will be signed for the
duration of the closure.
